The Texas Association of Licensed Investigators Commendations Committee is pleased to announce the latest recipient of TALI's prestigious Meritorious Service Award for Investigative Excellence commendation awards:

Louis L. Akin, of Akin Investigations, Austin, Texas, is awarded the **Meritorious Service Award for Investigative Excellence 2007**, for discovering a wiretap installed on the telephone line beneath the home of an Austin woman. The discovery led to the arrest and conviction of a 55-year old Austin contractor who stalked, harassed, and psychologically tortured ex-girlfriends over the past 20-years. The contractor was convicted of wiretapping and burglary and sentenced to five years in prison. Akin previously received the TALI President's Award in 2006 for his work in public relations and as associate editor of the Texas Investigator magazine.
